Water Main Upgrade Project

Okanagan Falls Irrigation District has begun the first phase in its plan to upgrade the community water mains in order to improve the distribution system. The goal over the next 6 to 8 years is to bring the water flow up to a standard throughout the entire system in order to improve service to residents and to meet the needs of the community as it grows.

The first phase of the project, beginning April 18 will see a new 250 mm water main installed along McLean Creek Road from Mallory Crescent to Maple Street. The project will also include upgrades to service connections to homes on 14th Ave. from Shuttleworth Creek to Maple Street.

The project begins April 18, 2017 and is expected to be complete by June 30, 2017.

The Contractor for this project is H&M Excavating Ltd. of Penticton.

During this time, there will be some traffic interruptions, and possibly times that public in the area of the project will not have vehicular access to their property. H&M will do their best to notify those affected in advance and to keep the traffic interruptions as short as possible.
